Objectives: Advanced materials are used in a broad spectrum of applications in Aerospace, Aviation, Automotive, Medicine and Energy sectors. Multifunctional, smart and composite materials concentrate an attractive combination of properties, i.e. light weight, high stiffness, high strength, and in some cases they are thermo-mechanically triggered to deliver actuation properties.
